Leaving Chester Station at 8.45 am by Meredith's coach, the first visit will be to Llanarmon yn Ial to look at the 12th-century *tomen* (motte), then to the *Raven* inn (1722) for coffee and on to the twin-aisled church of St Garmon. We hope to see the stone circle near Nannerch and then go on to Halkyn Mountain, where we can view prehistoric sites, Roman lead-workings and other medieval workings; this will be our picnic stop. The last visit will be to Fflint castle, which is unusual in having the great keep separate from the inner ward.
